CHÂTEAU PEBY FAUGÈRES St.-Emilion 2010

Score: 92-95

This gushes with exotic fig sauce, mulled blueberry and blackberry fruit and enticing black tea, anise and charcoal notes. Long and very fleshy, with powerful, pure fruit in reserve. —*J.M.*

CHÂTEAU FAUGÈRES St.-Emilion 2010

Score: 91-94

This delivers a pure beam of raspberry and blueberry fruit that's nicely rounded, with plenty of stuffing on the back end. Violet and anise notes flitter through with buried minerality. —*J.M.*

CHÂTEAU CAP DE FAUGÈRES Côtes de Castillon 2010

Score: 89-92

This has a fresh, invigorating feel, with bright acidity and floral notes cutting through the plum and black cherry fruit nicely. The finish is long and silky. Delicious. —*J.M.*
